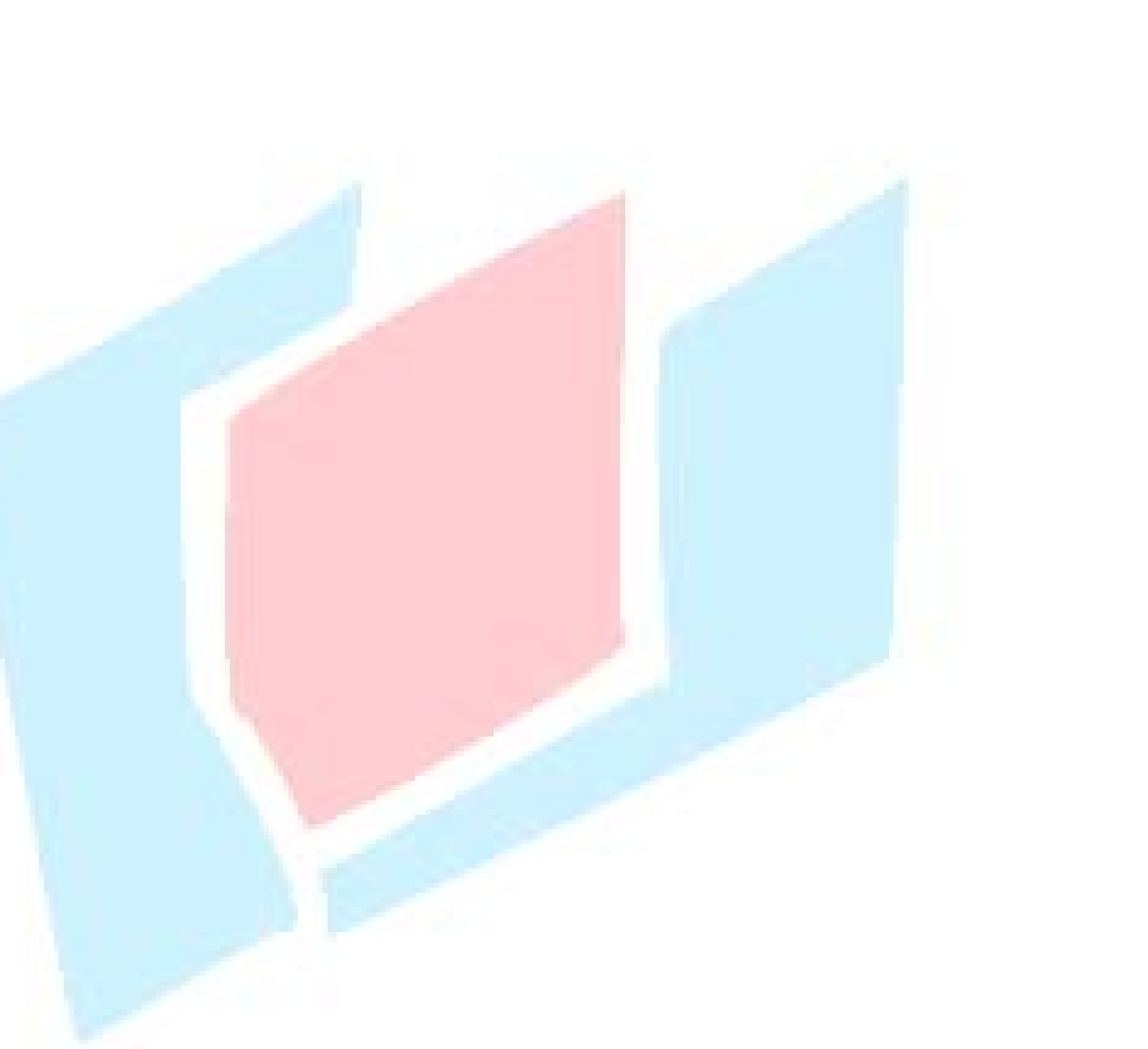
**GTI-PC IDE: the Spanish interdisciplinary working group on Cartographic Heritage and the SDI** presented a crosswalk between MARC21 and ISO19155 with the objective to approach the map libraries to the SDI technologies. This working group who started its activities in 2008, is part of the Spanish Commission on SDI and comprises members from different institutions as map libraries, map agencies and university departments

**Digitalization and web distribution:** most of the main libraries have digitalization projects and web digital maps. There are some federated experiences

- A lot of public Spanish map libraries are captured in *Europeana* as well as in *Hispana*, the Spanish digital web
- *Digital Memory of Catalonia*: part of digital items is maps. There is an effort to include small and also private significant maps collections (Centre Excursionista de Catalunya, Biblioteca Balaguer, etc.) [mdc.cbuc.cat](http://mdc.cbuc.cat)
- *Singularis*: digitalization project of the Madrid University Libraries contain some ancient maps [www.singularis.es](http://www.singularis.es)
